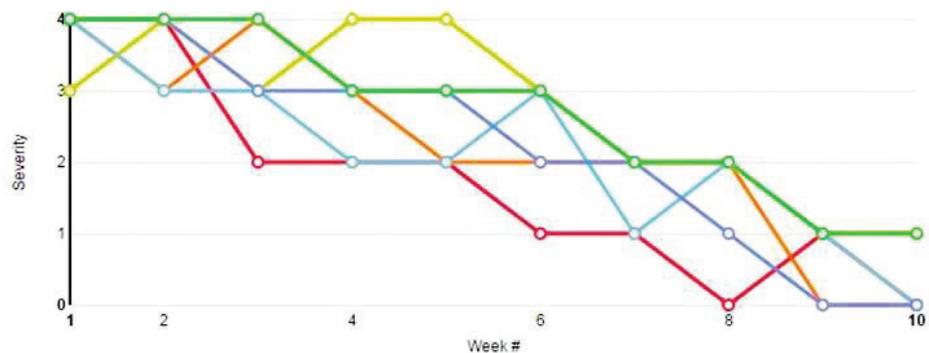

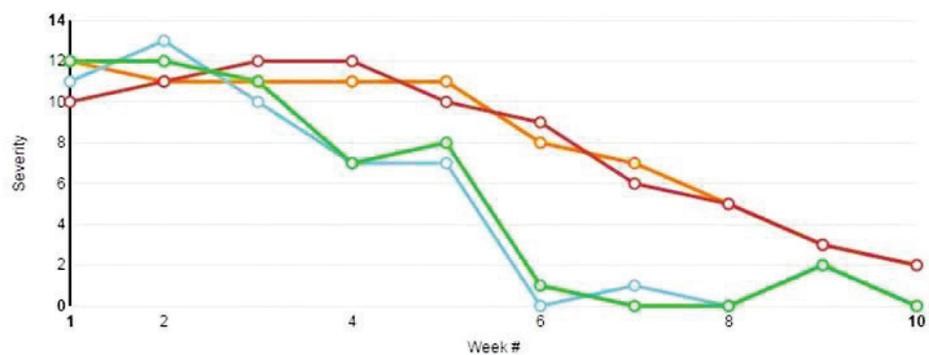


FIGURE 29.1. Measurement feedback system client dashboard used to inform clinician decision making for a youth who presented with anxiety and conduct problems at pretreatment. The dashboard displays weekly caregiver- and youth-report ratings of informant-identified “top problems” and of a standardized measure of internalizing and externalizing problems throughout the 10-week treatment. Copyright © Jacqueline Hersh and John R. Weisz. Reprinted by permission.

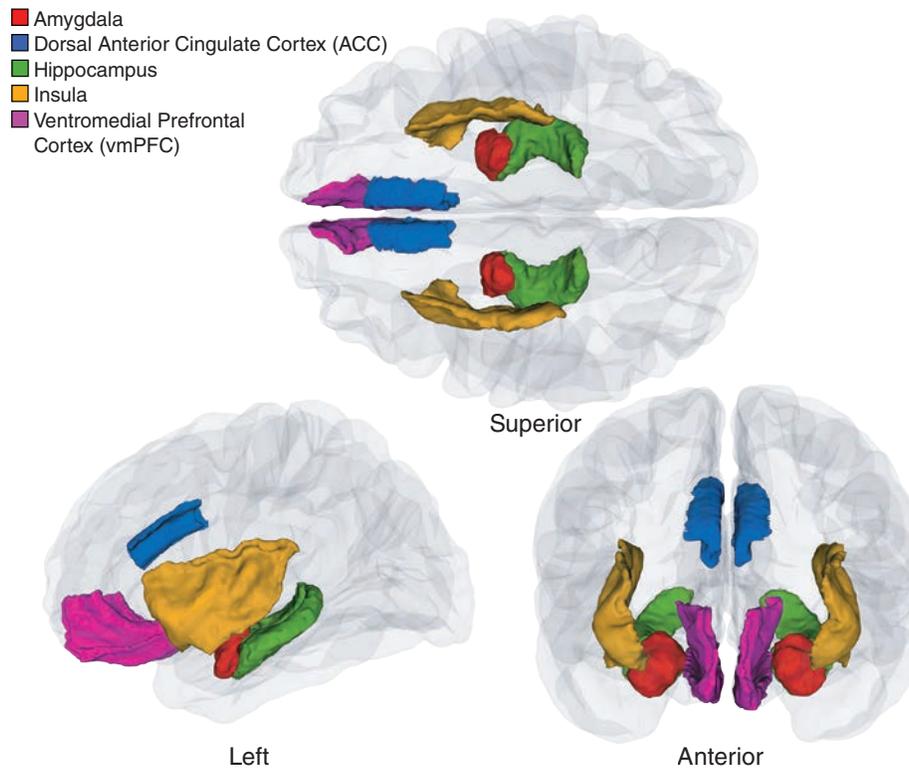


FIGURE 30.1. Key brain regions involved in fear learning and salience processing (brain data from Freesurfer: <http://surfer.nmr.mgh.harvard.edu>).

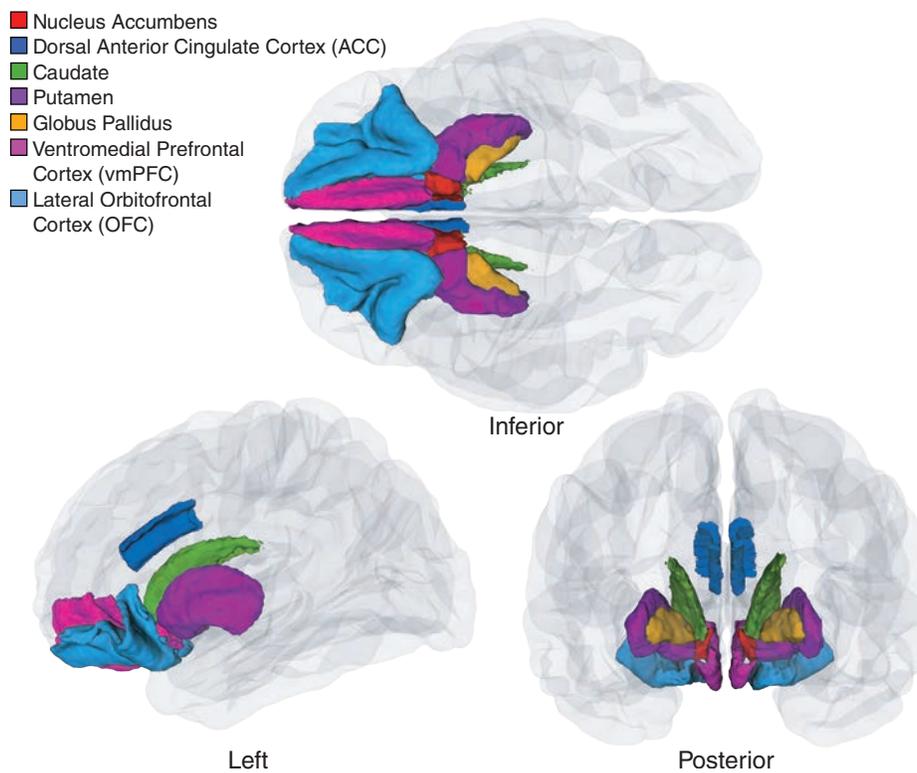


FIGURE 30.2. Key brain regions involved in reward processing (brain data from Freesurfer: <http://surfer.nmr.mgh.harvard.edu>).
